



HOW TO GO TO FRIDAYS PUERTO GALERA

1. Private Car (Going to Batangas Port)

From Manila, proceed south along the South Luzon Expressway (SLEX or South Superhighway). From the Makati EDSA flyover it is approximately 40km to the Calamba toll plaza. From there proceed 3.1km to the Calamba exit and exit to the right towards Sto. Thomas and Batangas. Proceed towards Sto Thomas for 7.5km where you will see a large green sign on your right pointing to the new STAR Tollway to Batangas. Follow the sign to Batangas. Zero your tropometer just after the Batangas Exit toll plaza.

At the Batangas Port exit, proceed straight ahead for 3.9km to the Bauan overpass. Go straight and drive through the flyover until you reach the port entrance at approximately 6.3km.

2. Public Bus (Going to Batangas Port)

Go to any of the following bus terminals in Metro Manila going to Batangas Port:

- Bus Terminal near the corner of Taft Avenue and Gil Puyat Avenue (formerly Buendia) Beside McDonalds, Pasay City – nearest to Ninoy Aquino International Airport and Domestic Airport
- Bus Terminal near Ali Mall, Araneta Center, Cubao, Quezon City
- Bus Terminal in EDSA corner Kamias Street, Quezon City
- Bus Terminal in Alabang, Muntinlupa City

Take an air-conditioned bus going straight to Batangas Pier via CALABARZON Expressway. Travel time to Batangas pier is about 2 hours and the fare is less than 200 pesos.

Upon arriving at Batangas Pier, go to the following terminal:

- Terminal III for Ro-Ro vessels bound to Balatero Port Puerto Galera.
- Terminal II for Fastcraft vessels bound to Muelle Port Puerto Galera.

3. Booking websites offering advance purchase of ferry tickets

- An Environmental Tax (non-residents only) of 50 pesos upon arrival at any ports in Puerto Galera shall be paid upon arrival.
- If taking bound to Balatero please take a trike or pre-arranged van from Balatero Port to Muelle Port.
- From Muelle Port, Fridays Puerto Galera provides complimentary scheduled boat shuttle upon your arrival and on your departure. For a hassle-free transportation please contact Fridays Puerto Galera Front Desk at 09176307767, or just text your full name, boat departure time and the name of the vessel you are taking

4. Manila to Puerto Galera via Airtrav

All seaplane flights to and from Manila shall arrive and depart at **CCP Bay Terminal Pasay City**. Search on Google maps, Waze or Uber/ Grab Taxi for "Airtrav Seaplane Terminal". It is usually a 40-minute flight from Manila to Puerto Galera, and guests are dropped off straight at Fridays Puerto Galera, Boquete Island.
